I am writing to make you aware of the forthcoming Clock Restoration

Thanks to the generosity of the public, Langport Town Trust are delighted to announce that the Town Clock Restoration is due to start on 28th August

We are carrying out the project in two phases to reduce disruption as much as possible

- Phase One – 28 August to 1 September, 2018
- Phase Two – 11 to 13 September, 2018

- Due to the size of the clock, the scaffolding will infringe onto the road
- Unfortunately this means we have to have single file traffic and 3 way traffic lights.
- However, these will be manned by an operative from 08:00 – 18:00 each day to ensure the traffic flows as smoothly as possible and to allow for the bus stops to operate as normal.

We apologise in advance for any inconvenience and ask for your cooperation and support during this project

For example:

- Please be patient at the Traffic Lights.
- Let delivery companies know and ask them not to stop to unload on Bow street. Please use the free car parks instead
- Pedestrians – please take care when crossing the road as the main Zebra Crossing will be closed
