RULES OF THE FRIENDS OF LANGPORT SURGERY (FOLS) LUCKY NUMBERS CLUB

1. The Club shall be known as the Friends of Langport Surgery (FOLS) Lucky Numbers Club.
2. Membership is open to anyone who wishes to support our work for the benefits of patients within Langport Surgery. The minimum age of participants is 18.
3. Membership is by the purchase of a minimum of one share at £1.00 per month and should be for a subscription of 12 months. There is no limit to the number of shares that can be purchased. You can join the scheme in any month but your subscription should be submitted to the Treasurer, FOLS and handed into the surgery by the 15th of the month you wish to join.
4. The percentage of income distributed in prizes shall be at the discretion of the Committee of Friends of Langport Surgery but at no time will these be less than 20% of the total income.
5. All paid up members will be entered for each month's draw according to their shareholding.
6. A draw will take place in the surgery at the end of every month and witnessed by members of the committee.
7. Winners will be advised by email or telephone and the numbers displayed on the screens in the surgery but not the names of the winners.
8. Income over and above the prize money will be retained by FOLS to support their work.
9. The club will be managed by the FOLS Committee.
10. Under the terms of data protection all details of members of the scheme are only used in the operation of the scheme.
